Academic Excellence Scholarship

The Academic Excellence Scholarship is available to students with an exemplary academic record who have demonstrated outstanding application and achievement across the curriculum.

The successful applicant(s) will display a joy for learning, outstanding work ethic and behaviour and a preparedness to participate fully in the life of St Albans Secondary College.

Please note that the Academic Excellence Scholarship is only available to students applying for entry to the SEAL Program. Students applying for the SEAL Program are automatically considered for an Academic Excellence Scholarship. For more information, please see the SEAL Program brochure.



Sports Scholarship

The Sports Scholarship is available to keen sportspersons who have shown outstanding aptitude and personal achievement in one or many sporting field(s). Applicants will have personal qualities of good sportsmanship, leadership and will demonstrate an eagerness to commit to the College's Sports Program.

Leadership Scholarship

The Leadership Scholarship is available to students who have demonstrated leadership skills. The successful applicant(s) will have excellent communication skills, display initiative, and have a passion to motivate, delegate, guide and direct fellow students. They will display an outstanding work ethic and behaviour and be encouraging and supportive of their peers.

Citizenship Scholarship

The Citizenship Scholarship is available to students who have made a significant demonstrable contribution to their community. The successful applicant(s) will display a strong social conscience as well as an outstanding work ethic and behaviour and a preparedness to participate fully in the life of St Albans Secondary College.

Visual and Performing Arts Scholarship

The Visual and Performing Arts scholarship is available to students who demonstrate exceptional talent in one or more of the fields of music, drama, dance, and visual art (such as painting, drawing, or sculpting). Scholarships will be awarded to students based on talent, potential and a positive work ethic. Suitable candidates will display an eagerness to participate fully in the opportunities on offer, such as the College's music theatre production, choirs, competitions, and other school events.



SELECTION

Year 7 Scholarship recipients will be selected based on an online application via the school website at www.stalbanssc.vic.edu.au. Supporting documentation, such as letters of recommendation, certificates of achievement, work samples and school reports can also be uploaded online.

You will be contacted by the College regarding the status of your application. Shortlisted applicants will be required to attend an interview. During the interview your child will have the opportunity to showcase their talent, demonstrate a commitment to their studies, as well as a willingness and enthusiasm to contribute to the school community.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

2. Click on the 'SEAL and Scholarship Application' icon on the homepage
3. Complete the online SEAL Program and Scholarship Application form. You will need to upload:
 - Year 5 NAPLAN results
 - most recent school reports
 - handwritten writing sample
 - your child's current primary teacher's email address
 - further evidence for the scholarship, for example: video of achievements, photos of medals/ribbons, certificates, letters of recommendation from teachers/coaches, etc.

Applications can be saved and continued later if needed.

Please note: you can apply for more than one scholarship. You may also apply for scholarships in addition to the Academic Excellence Scholarship / SEAL Program. You will need to indicate this by ticking the relevant boxes on the online application form.

If you require support with the application process, please contact the College by 1 May 2020.
